

Umm 'Aṭiyyah states: "The Prophet (sws) sent an army in which 'Alī was present. I heard him say while raising his hands: 'Do not make me die unless I see 'Alī."

Abū al-Jarrāh is *majhūl al-'ayn* as the only person that narrates from him is Abū 'Āṣim al-Nabīl.² Thus al-Dhahabī says that he is $majh\bar{u}l$ even though al-Tirmidhī has classified this narrative as hasan.³

While Yaḥyā ibn Ma'īn and others regard Jābir ibn Ṣubayh to be reliable, al-Azdī says *lā yaqūm ḥadīthuhū*.⁴
